



# MA in Latin American Studies

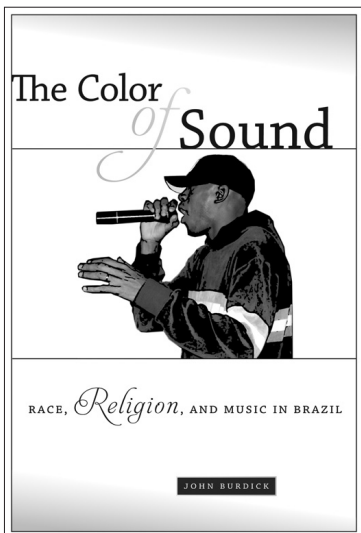

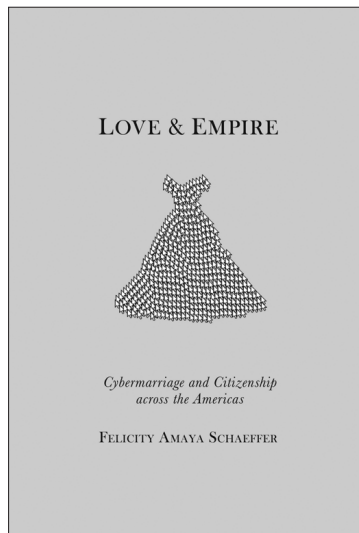
